**Mid Ohio Oncology/Hematology Announces Grand
Opening of The Mark H. Zangmeister Center**
Complete service facility to bring new face to cancer treatment options

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Mark H. Zangmeister Center, a new, full service cancer care facility created by Mid Ohio Oncology/Hematology (MOOH), will open on May 29, 2007. The center is the first of its kind in Ohio and will deliver the most progressive cancer treatment available to more than 16,000 patients annually.

Raising the bar for cancer care in central Ohio, the 109,000-square-foot facility was built with patient service at the forefront. The Zangmeister Center will provide outpatient treatment for cancer and blood disorders and will include an on-site specialty pharmacy, a physician clinic, chemotherapy treatment, infusion services, radiation therapy, imaging services, gynecologic oncology and wellness services including patient education, counseling and psychosocial services.

Along with state-of-the-art treatment facilities, the center provides a comfortable atmosphere to put patients at ease. The new facility has been designed to create more intimate settings in the physicians' offices and in the treatment, laboratory and diagnostic imaging areas. The environment includes fountains, fish tanks, plenty of windows and natural light. Public Wi Fi, a resource center and a multi-purpose room for programming are just a few of the added services available to patients.

The new center is named after Dr. Mark H. Zangmeister, one of central Ohio's most respected oncology physicians, who was an integral part of MOOH for many years. His son, Dr. Jeffrey Zangmeister, is a practicing physician with the group.

"We are thrilled to bring this unique facility to central Ohio," said Glenn Balasky, executive director of MOOH and The Zangmeister Center. "The ability to meet current and future care needs and the benefits the center provides to the community are unmatched."

MOOH currently serves 9,000 patients each year at its eight central Ohio locations. Four Columbus-area locations will move to The Zangmeister Center, and Mid Ohio physicians will continue to serve patients at facilities in Chillicothe, London and Delaware.

The Grand Opening events will take place on Tuesday, May 29 with a ceremony and tours of the center with state and local officials.

The Zangmeister Center is located at 1-670 and the Cassady Avenue exit, near the Columbus Airport.
